Have you really ever had this practice? If not, then are you open to starting?

- (#5) How sure are you that you will go to Heaven when you die?

- (#6) If God asked you right now: “Why should I let you into My Heaven to be with Me forever?”  
 How would you answer Him?
- (#7) Please write out your testimony:  
 - Who were you before believing in Jesus?  
 - Specifically, how & when did you accept Jesus?  
 - How has He changed you, or how has your life been different since?  
 - *(make sure to type & save this portion for future reference)*
- (#8) Describe your walk (*relationship*) with Christ in the past 6 months.  
 Within this, share about your prayer & Bible study habits.  
 What scripture have you been studying this past month?  
 Do you journal, or ever write anything down?
- (#9) In your opinion, what kind of Leader was Jesus?
- (#10) Why do you want to help lead & serve in the Junior High ministry?  
 Why Junior High, instead of other areas of ministry?
- (#11) If a student came up to you and wanted to know:  
 “How can I become a Christian?”- what would you pray, or share with them?
- (#12) What would you say is one of your greatest strengths for Jr.High ministry?  
 What is one of your greatest weaknesses, or makes you uncomfortable?
- (#13) Would you be bringing any gifts or skills that we can use at XZONE?  
*(computer skills, drama experience, artistry, etc...)*

Obviously, these are a lot of thought-provoking questions, but this process is designed to challenge you, and make you think. Thank you for taking the time to fill out these questions, and having a heart for teenagers. This process is about your growth as a Christian leader; and we’re looking for people called to serve.
